- SSSR** = Single Shuttle Split Ring (Loop Over Method)
 - = Bead
 - or p = Picot (all picots very small)
 - + = Join
 - slj = Shuttle lock join
 - "=" or • = Next picot to be joined
 - . = Close ring
 - rw = Reverse work

R1 (6): 6 • 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R2 (5): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R3 (4): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 8 • .

R4 (3): 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 - 6., rw

R5 (5): 6 + (1st • R1) 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R6 (5): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R7 (4): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 8 • ., slj p R4, push up •

SSSR 8 (3): 4 / 1 - 1 • 1 • 1 • 2., push up •

R9 (4): 8 + (• R7) 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R10 (5): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R11 (4): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 8 • ., rw

R12 (3): 6 + (p SSSR 8) 2 • 1 • 1 • 2., rw, push up •

R13 (3): 2 • 1 • 1 • 1 - 6., rw

R14 (4): 8 + (3rd • R3) 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

***R15** (5): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R7 (4): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 8 • ., slj (p R13), push up •

SSSR 8: (3): 4 / 1 - 1 • 1 • 1 • 2., push up •

R9 (4): 8 + (• R7) 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R10 (5): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .

R11 (4): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 • 8 • ., rw

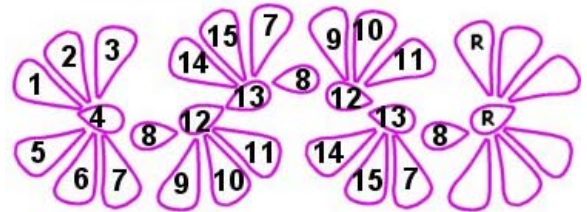
R12 (3): 6 + (p SSSR 8) 2 • 1 • 1 • 2., rw, push up •

R13 (3): 2 • 1 • 1 • 2 - 6., rw

R14 (4): 8 + (3rd • R11) 1 • 1 • 2 • 6 • .*

Repeat from * to * for length, ending with **R12** at desired length.

Valise LOP



To end the pattern, complete **R12**, omit **R13**

Repeat **R3**, **R2**, **R2**, rw

R (3): 6 + (p SSSR 8) 2 • 1 • 1 • 2., rw

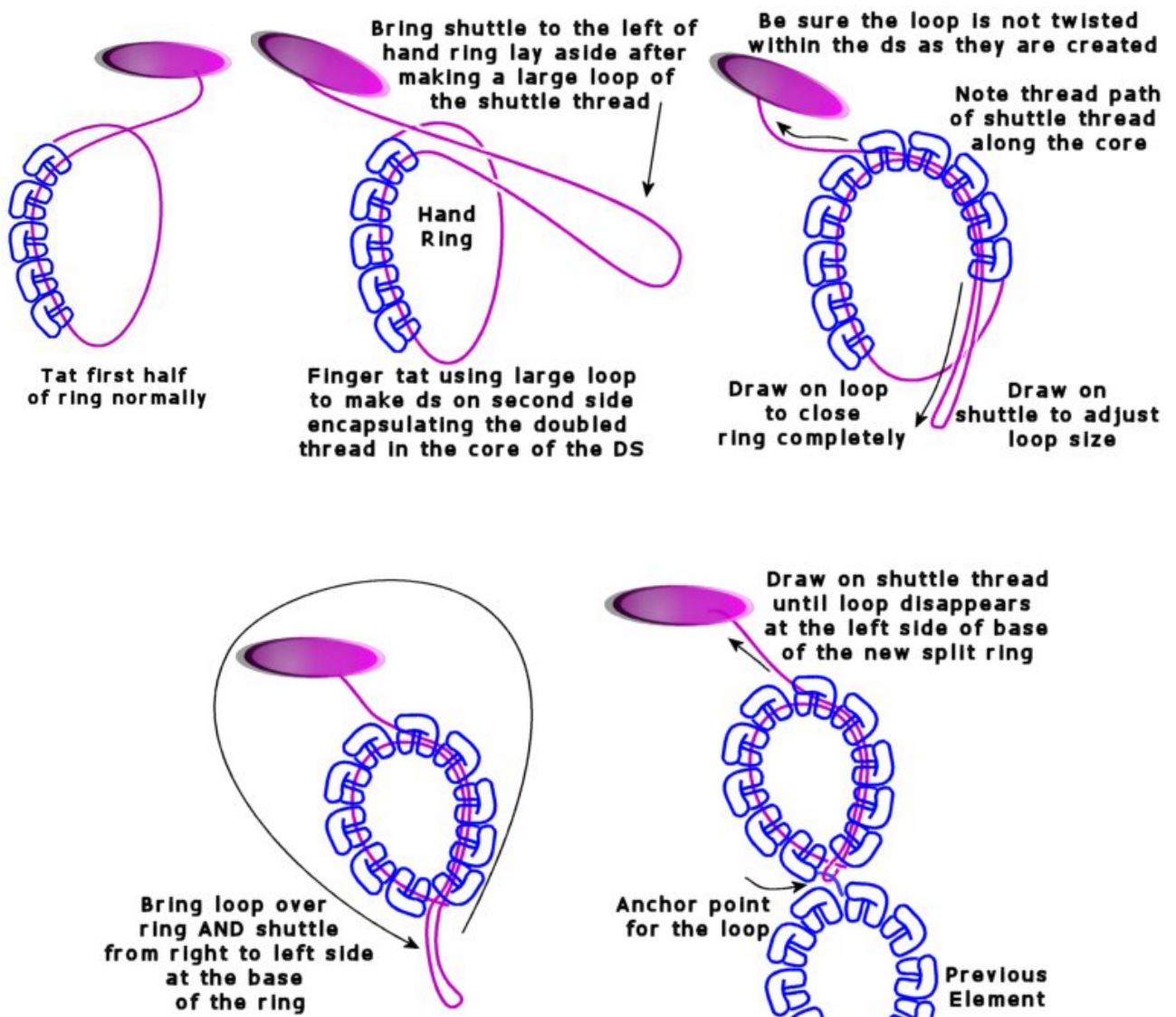
Repeat R6, 5

R (3): 6 + 2 • 1 • 1 + (• R7) 8 •.

Use thread end to sew down through the centerline of beads, tacking at even intervals if making the barrette.

Single Shuttle Split Ring (Loop Over Method) Technique by Matthew Takeda

This ring is a stand-alone ring. Picots can be added to this ring, but they cannot be joined to previous work. The loop needs an anchor point and must be able to get over both the shuttle and the ring unless a different anchor is provided.



Valisa without beads

R1: 6 - 6 = 6.

R2: 6 + 6 = 6.

R3: 6 + 6 - 6.

R4: 6 - 6, rw

R5: 6 + (p R1) 6 = 6.

R6: 6 + 6 = 6.

R7: 6 + 6 - 6., slj (p R4)

SSSR 8: 6 / 1 - 5.

R9: 6 + (p R7) 6 = 6.

R10: 6 + 6 = 6.

R11: 6 + 6 - 6., rw

R12: 6 + (p SSSR 8) 6., rw

R13: 6 - 6., rw

R14: 6 + (p R3) 6 = 6.

R15: 6 + 6 = 6.

Repeat from **R7** to **R15** for length, ending with **R12** at desired length

To end the pattern, complete **R12**, omit **R13**

Repeat **R3**, **R2**, **R2**, rw

R: 6 + (p SSSR 8) 6., rw

Repeat **R6**, **R5**

R: 6 + 6 +(• R7) 6 •.

Use thread end to sew down through the centerline of beads, tacking at even intervals if making the barrette.

Threads/Beads: Size 20 thread / Size 11 beads, Size 80 thread / Size 15 beads

Notes:
